The United States Constitution

Article II, Section 1 of the U.S. Constitution imposes only three eligibility requirements on persons serving as president, based on the officeholder's age, time of residency in the U.S., and citizenship status:

U.S. Constitution – Presidential Candidate Eligibility

"No person except a natural born Citizen, or a Citizen of the United States, at the time of the Adoption of this Constitution, shall be eligible to the Office of President; neither shall any person be eligible to that Office who shall not have attained to the Age of thirty-five Years, and been fourteen Years a Resident within the United States."

Executive Grant of Clemency

to Hasan Piker and Medea Benjamin

BY THE PRESIDENT OF THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA A PROCLAMATION

By the authority vested in me as President by the Constitution and the laws of the United States of America, it is hereby ordered as follows:

By the authority vested in me as President by the Constitution and the laws of the United States, including Article II, Section 2, Clause 1 of the Constitution:

WHEREAS certain federal statutes and regulations, including the Trading with the Enemy Act, the Cuban Assets Control Regulations, and related sanctions authorities, have imposed restrictions on travel and financial transactions involving Cuba;

WHEREAS activities relating to political advocacy, journalism, humanitarian engagement, and public discourse occupy an important place within the constitutional traditions of the United States;

WHEREAS Medea Benjamin and Hasan Piker have engaged in public advocacy and activities relating to Cuba that have not been shown to involve espionage, violence, or intent to harm the national security of the United States;

WHEREAS the interests of justice and equity are served by resolving any potential federal criminal liability arising from such conduct;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Vincent Cordova, President of the United States, do hereby grant a full, complete, and unconditional pardon unto:

Medea Benjamin, for any and all offenses against the United States arising under the Trading with the Enemy Act, the Cuban Assets Control Regulations, the International Emergency Economic Powers Act, or related federal sanctions laws or regulations, for conduct occurring on or before the date of this proclamation;

and

Hasan Piker, for any and all offenses against the United States arising under the Trading with the Enemy Act, the Cuban Assets Control Regulations, the International Emergency Economic Powers Act, or related federal sanctions laws or regulations, for conduct occurring on or before the date of this proclamation.

This pardon applies to any federal investigation, charge, prosecution, conviction, or penalty arising from such conduct occurring on or before the date of this proclamation.

This grant of clemency shall not apply to offenses involving violence, fraud, espionage, or the unlawful provision of material support to a foreign terrorist organization.

The Attorney General is directed to take all lawful and appropriate steps within the authority of the Executive Branch to give full effect to this pardon.
