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The United States Constitution

Article II, Section 1 of the U.S. Constitution imposes only three eligibility requirements on persons serving as president, based on the officeholder's age, time of residency in the U.S., and citizenship status:

U.S. Constitution – Presidential Candidate Eligibility

"No person except a natural born Citizen, or a Citizen of the United States, at the time of the Adoption of this Constitution, shall be eligible to the Office of President; neither shall any person be eligible to that Office who shall not have attained to the Age of thirty-five Years, and been fourteen Years a Resident within the United States."

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CORDOVA 2028 RELEASES MOST COMPREHENSIVE PRESIDENTIAL CAMPAIGN FRAMEWORK EVER PRODUCED ON FOREIGN ELECTORAL INTERFERENCE

Complete Seven-Document American Electoral Sovereignty Framework Includes Draft Legislation, Day One Executive Order, Presidential Proclamation, and Full Constitutional Defense

Campaign Declares AIPAC a National Security Threat; Calls for Immediate FARA Enforcement, IEEPA Sanctions, and Congressional Action

MANTECA, CALIFORNIA — The Cordova 2028 presidential campaign today released the **American Electoral Sovereignty Framework** — a complete, seven-document policy, legislative, and constitutional package addressing what the campaign describes as the most



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serious and least prosecuted foreign influence operation in American history: the systematic use of foreign-aligned money to purchase seats in the United States Congress.

WHAT WAS RELEASED TODAY

The American Electoral Sovereignty Framework consists of seven interconnected documents:

- 1. Official Campaign Policy Position** — A comprehensive statement of facts, legal analysis, and policy commitments establishing AIPAC and its affiliated organizations as a national security threat requiring immediate executive and legislative action.
- 2. The American Electoral Sovereignty Act** — Fully drafted legislation for immediate introduction in Congress that prohibits foreign-aligned organizations from participating in American federal elections, closes shell PAC and dark money loopholes, establishes mandatory source disclosure requirements, and creates criminal penalties of up to fifteen years for those who operate deceptive foreign-aligned influence structures.
- 3. Executive Order on Defending American Electoral Sovereignty** — A complete, legally vetted executive order ready for signature on Day One of the Cordova administration, activating mandatory FARA enforcement, IEEPA sanctions authority, a Foreign Electoral Sovereignty Task Force, federal contractor prohibitions, and a congressional protection mechanism.
- 4. Presidential Proclamation** — A formal declaration to the nation and to history on the sovereignty of the American electoral process.
- 5. White House Press Statement** — A complete Day One media package including statements from the President, Attorney General, and Director of National Intelligence, with a full Day 1 through Day 120 implementation timeline.
- 6. Constitutional Defense Brief** — A comprehensive legal defense of the Executive Order grounded in nine Supreme Court precedents, including *Bluman v. FEC* (2012), *Dames & Moore v. Regan* (1981), *Youngstown Sheet & Tube Co. v. Sawyer* (1952), and *Meese v. Keene* (1987).
- 7. Constitutional Defense Brief Addendum** — An extended constitutional analysis presenting six additional legal arguments rooted in the Ninth Amendment, the Article IV Guarantee Clause,



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the Declaration of Independence, the Preamble, structural constitutional integrity, and the First Amendment inversion doctrine.

STATEMENT FROM VINCENT CORDOVA

"What we are releasing today is not a campaign promise. It is a governing blueprint. The legal work is done. The executive order is drafted. The legislation is written. The constitutional defense is built.

AIPAC has spent over \$221 million purchasing seats in the United States Congress. It has done this through shell PAC structures deliberately designed to hide its involvement from American voters. It has financially destroyed members of Congress for exercising independent judgment on matters of American foreign policy and national security. If any other foreign-aligned organization — Russian, Chinese, Iranian, or otherwise — had done a fraction of this, the full force of American national security would have responded years ago.

The double standard ends with our administration. The law will be applied equally to every foreign-aligned actor, without exception, without diplomatic carve-outs, and without political interference. The United States Congress belongs to the American people. On Day One, we begin taking it back."

KEY FACTS

- AIPAC and affiliated organizations have spent **over \$221 million** in American congressional elections since 2021 — the single largest special-interest electoral spending operation in the current cycle.
- AIPAC-aligned outside spending in Illinois primaries alone reached **\$21.6 million** — exceeding what the candidates themselves spent by more than \$8 million.
- A Quinnipiac poll (August 2025) found **77% of Democrats** and **half of all voters** believe Israel is committing genocide. **60% of voters** disapprove of U.S. military aid to Israel.
- The Foreign Agents Registration Act has been law since **1938**. It has never been consistently enforced against organizations engaged in large-scale American electoral spending on behalf of foreign governments.



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- The national emergency covering foreign electoral interference — **Executive Order 13848** — has been in continuous force since 2018, providing the President with existing IEEPA sanctions authority the Cordova administration will activate immediately.

THE CONSTITUTIONAL ARGUMENT

The Cordova campaign's Constitutional Defense Addendum advances what legal scholars have described as an underutilized but potentially decisive argument: the **Ninth Amendment** protection of unenumerated rights retained by the American people.

The campaign's position: The right of the American people to govern themselves through elections that are genuinely their own is the most fundamental unenumerated right protected by the Ninth Amendment — the right from which all other constitutional rights derive their meaning and protection. Foreign-aligned electoral spending does not exercise a constitutional right. It destroys the most foundational one.

The Addendum further argues that under the Article IV **Guarantee Clause** — which obligates the United States to guarantee every state a republican form of government — a Congress whose composition is systematically determined by foreign-aligned money does not constitute a republican form of government in any meaningful constitutional sense. Supreme Court precedent establishes that Guarantee Clause enforcement is committed to the political branches, not the judiciary — meaning the President's determination that foreign-aligned electoral capture threatens the republican form of government is not subject to judicial override.

THE EQUAL APPLICATION PRINCIPLE

A centerpiece of the framework is its absolute equal application mandate. The Executive Order's Section 10 states explicitly: what is prohibited for Russia is prohibited for Israel; what is prohibited for China is prohibited for Saudi Arabia; what is prohibited for Iran is prohibited for the United Kingdom. All authorities will be applied without regard to which foreign nation's interests are being advanced, any diplomatic relationship with that nation, or any political or commercial consideration.

"This is not about Israel. This is not about Jewish Americans. This is about the United States Congress and who it answers to. The law applies equally to all foreign-aligned actors. That is



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the only position consistent with the rule of law — and it is the only position this administration will take." — Vincent Cordova

CALL TO CONGRESS

The Cordova campaign today called on members of Congress to co-sponsor the American Electoral Sovereignty Act immediately and to publicly commit to its passage.

"Every member of Congress knows what AIPAC's money did to their elections and the elections of their colleagues. Every member knows what it means to face \$10 million in opposition spending for casting an independent vote. We are offering them a choice: stand with the American people and pass this legislation, or stand with the organization that purchased your seat and explain that choice to your constituents in 2028."
